- 🍅 Start off with a quote, a question, or a bold, audacious statement.
- 🍅 Elaborate on your main topic 3-4 sentences.

Interesting Supporting Points

This is the body of the article. Consider what you want to say and how you will back it up. A great way to organize is to make a list of bullet points. Then, write the body of the post using these as your main sections.
